• **Real estate agents** A person who helps apartment or house buyers find apartments or houses

for sale or rent

Break in Enter by force, especially to steal something

• **Maintenance staff** People who are responsible for repairing things that need fixing in

apartments, such as plumbing or electrical problems

• Let's keep looking Let's continue looking

Sigh
A loud breath expressing disappointment or relief

Bathtub A place to take a bath, so you don't have to stand like taking a shower

• **What'cha** What are you (pronounced quickly)

• 'Cuz Because (pronounced quickly)

• **Lemme** Let me (pronounced quickly)

Ummmmm A sound you make when you're thinking and not sure what to say

Ugh A sound you make when you're disgusted
