- **Netflix** An online service where you can watch TV shows online, similar to Amazon Prime Video
 - **Bucks** Slang for US Dollars
 - **Stand-up comedy specials** A TV program where it's just one person on stage telling jokes, usually about 1 hour
 - **Subtitles** Sentences shown at the bottom of the TV show or movie that translate what is being said
 - **Interesting** Something that holds your attention, or makes you interested
 - **Sign up** To begin a contract with a service so you can join or do something
 - **OMG** Oh my God
 - **Have'ta** Have to (pronounced quickly)
 - **Did'ju** Did you (pronounced quickly)
 - **C'mon** Come on (pronounced quickly)
 - **Izzit** Is it (pronounced quickly)
